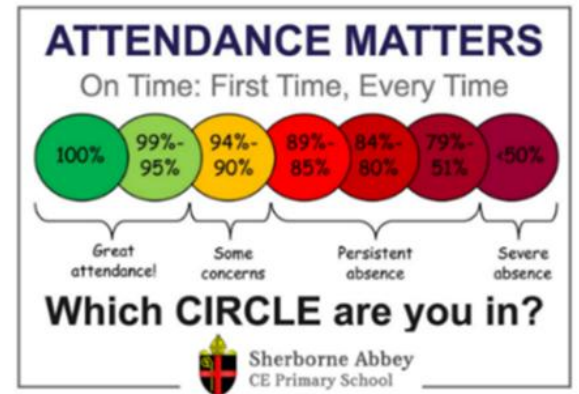


Strings @ Sherborne Girls
