Year 5 Archbishop Young Leaders Award (AYLA)

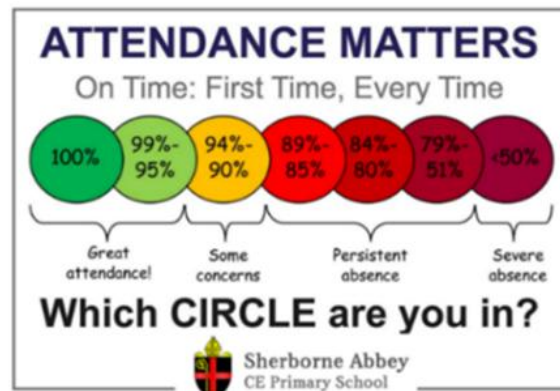
